Headlines

- Faculty-Staff apprehension: High and increasing since mid-July, similar to reports from other schools
- Gap between the level of educator and parent anxiety: 69% vs. 38%
- Families: Anxiety exists yet continued strong desire for on-campus instruction

- Social-Emotional Dynamics: Balance familiar connections and friendships with opportunities for new relationships

Intentional Design

- **Timetable**: Responsive to your feedback, less synchronous time on Zoom
- Schedule: Addresses unique needs of online education, not analog nor mirror of on-campus education
- Elasticity: Cohesive schoolwide plan but elastic enough so teachers can flex for unique grade-level needs
- Design: Academics tailored specifically for distance learning, smaller groups with specialists, tighter instruction time to optimize student attention
- **Cohorts**: Thoughtful and smaller for higher engagement and effective academics
- Delivery: Small-group and project work to deepen student motivation, concrete activities for breaks, multiple avenues for teacher feedback and assessment
- Creating normalcy: How students show up to school and go about the day
- **Vehicle**: Expanded iPad program to include all students K–5, tech upgrades
- Outcomes: KPI's to drive ongoing excellence
